

Gordon Chapel - Register of Deaths

1837-1848

The following entries are the Deaths 1837-1848 recorded in the Old Parish Registers for Gordon Chapel. The sequence begins in 1837 and was maintained until the closure of the chapel in 1848, following a dispute with the Duchess of Gordon. Images of the registers detailing these deaths are at the end of this document.

ROGERS	George son of William Rogers and Jean Menzies his wife was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie, May 20th 1837.
REEVE	Robert son of James Reeve and Mary his wife was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie, July 7th 1837.
BAXTER	James Baxter was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie on Thursday the 27th of July 1837.
REEVE	Michael son of James Reeve and Mary his wife was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie on the 10th Day of September 1837.
HUNTER	7 January 1838 Alexander infant son of Alexander Mary Hunter of the Parish of Speymouth was interred in the Church Yard of Dipple.
HUTCHEON	14 February 1838 Margaret Hutcheon of the Greens of Dipple was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie.
HOSACK	12 March 1838 George Hosack of Fochabers was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie.
HOSACK	9 April 1838 James Hosack of Fochabers, brother to the above George, was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie.
ALPHONSINE	23 June 1838 Francoise Alphonsine of Pau on the French Pyrennes was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie.
BIGSBY	25 August 1838 Edward Elliott third son of the Revd Charles Bigsby [Rector of Gordon Chapel] and Jane Christina his wife was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie.
MACINTOSH	8 October 1838 Alexina Macintosh Infant School Teacher [at the Episcopal School] was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie.
SMITH <i>[née Hutcheon]</i>	18 October 1838 Anne Hutcheon wife of James Smith of the Greens of Dipple was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie.
INNES	9 July 1839 Alexander Innes , labourer was in interred in the Church Yard of Bellie.
HEWSON	10 January 1840 William Henry son of Henry and Caroline Hewson was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie.
BAXTER	14 February 1840 James Baxter was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie.
LYONS	24 February 1840 Sophia wife of Samuel Athill Lyons, Captain in the 24th Regiment Native Infantry, Bengal was interred in the Church Yard of Bellie.

LOGIE	5 April 1853 Marian Logie third daughter of the late Lt-Col Logie of the 34th Regiment Bengal was interred the Church Yard of Bellie aged 29 years.
