REPORT FOR ISD GROUP ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Background

The ISD Group provides regular donations for the work of Busega Scotland in Tanzania.

The funds are used to support Mayega Children's Centre, a home for twenty-three children and young people.

Eight Tanzanian staff are employed at the Centre.

A qualified social worker is the officer-in-charge, and a teacher improves educational attainment.

Busega Scotland has also facilitated twelve women's groups close to Lake Victoria, supporting over 350 women in developing small businesses and improving the circumstances of their families.

Outcomes for 2023

Children arrive at Mayega from very difficult circumstances and with a lack of education.

Five children were admitted this year.

The Centre provides care and security, and the children become happier, more relaxed, and develop hope for their future.

Two children passed primary school leaving examinations and will proceed to secondary education.

One girl and two boys passed Form 4 secondary school examinations and proceeded to A level.

Four young people have achieved this milestone in the last two years, and there is tough competition for A level places.

There is now a pathway, supported by Busega Scotland, along which children from Mayega may proceed to university education.
